Congratulations to David & Carol on winning this, their first George Forrest Memorial Medal. It was especially sweet to win it at a 'local' show.

David was show secretary for this Discussion Weekend show in Grantown on Spey. Carol has been the main organiser of the 3 events there. They trumped the opposition with a very well flowered plant of the cross between C. africanum and C. hederifolium. It was the first Cyclamen hybrid to be recognised. It is reputed to be hardier that africanum abut less hardy than hederifolium.

The winning plant had exceptionally fine silver arrow shaped leaves which were an excellent foil to its pink flowers. The leaves were well developed and filled the pot. Often in Cyclamen the peak flowering is before full leaf development. The winning plant was shown paired up with a

sister C. x hildebrandii in a two pan class. The latter had white flowers and much darker leaves. Nice to see the variation! Once again well done Carol & David—a well deserved win!
