David scooped the prestigious Farrer medal with his outstanding and stand out pan of Narcissus obesus 'Lee Martin'. This form has won Forrest medal for Dave and the late Bill Robinson and in the right hands is a wonderful clone. Lee Martin himself won a Farrer medal at the AGS South west Show in 2004 with the clone which now bears his name.

I don't know how much bench space it needs but in order to keep its leaves in pristine condition it must have a square yard to itself. How many bulbs are in this pot? When do you first water it to get it to flower for show day? How do you transport it? How do you even left it? Ask Dave!



Lee Martin died in March 2020 aged 69. He was a distinguished exhibitor and judge at AGS shows. During his showing career he won 36 Farrer medals and over 1000 first prizes.
